#### NEGOTIATIONS UPDATE

With summer approaching, the Millard Public Schools and Millard Education Association have decided to extend negotiations for the new collective bargaining agreement (contract), effective September of 2009, into the summer.

We are not at an impasse. Talks have been spirited but constructive. The principal source of the delay in coming to an agreement stems from the state budgeting process, which as yet has not settled on a funding package for schools. The current

contract does not expire until August 31st. Both sides hope for a settlement in late May or early June. Association members will receive more information on voting for the contract, as well as cluster meetings, as we near a tentative agreement..
