

2018 TAX INFORMATION

IF YOU PAY DUES VIA PAYROLL DEDUCTION, THE FOLLOWING APPLIES:

\$741.80 for full-time. This includes 8 months (January-August) of 17-18 dues (\$592.00) and 2 months (November-December) of 18-19 dues (\$149.80).

\$382.40 for half-time. This includes 8 months (January-August) of 17-18 dues (\$305.20) and 2 months (November-December) of 18-19 dues (\$77.20).

**Total dues paid for 2018 can be found on your final paycheck stub from December 2018.

IF YOU PAY DUES VIA ELECTRONIC FUNDS TRANSFER, THE FOLLOWING APPLIES:

\$742.70 for full-time. This includes 7 months (January-July) of 17-18 dues (\$518.00) and 3 months (October-December) of 18-19 dues (\$224.70).

\$382.85 for half-time. This includes 7 months (January-July) of 17-18 dues (\$267.05) and 3 months (October-December) of 18-19 dues (\$115.80).

For 2018, Educators need to be aware of the changes to the new Form 1040 and its schedules.

1. Educators file the Form 1040 in order to take the deduction for up to \$250.00 of out-of-pocket classroom expenses (\$500.00 for married filing jointly and both spouses are eligible educators). The Form 1040A has been eliminated.
2. The deduction for educator's expenses is now claimed on Line 23 of the **Form 1040, Schedule 1 - Additional Income and Adjustments to Income**. That number is then subtracted (along with any other adjustments to income) from Line 6 of the Form 1040, Page 2(Total Income).

Any Educator Expenses in excess of the \$250.00 per Educator can no longer be deducted on the Schedule A.
