### 2. Day 194

There is a place on the intranet where staff can give suggestions for 09-10 on what they would like offered. It needs to be something that is productive for staff development time that relates to the Strategic Plan. PLC's will continue as an option.

## 3. Action Teams at buildings

It is not required for staff to participate in an Action Team. It is the hope of the district that staff will want to participate in the decision-making. It was discussed that many teachers would like to be involved but they are unable to stay late for meetings. It was noted that since it isn't something that is required a teacher can leave the meetings at any time.

## 4. PLP's at High School

It is a graduation requirement. It should be a collaborative process. Mentoring is done in homeroom with seniors to freshman. The recording process happens in homeroom. The students are held accountable in all of the high schools. PLP's should be authentic. PLP's may fit into the classroom but it is part of the counseling curriculum.

#### 5. Additional Item: Fall Workshop

Kim Saum-Mills discussed ideas on how to notify teachers about the fall workshop. The information could be posted on the Millard website instead of sending each returning staff member a manila envelope over the summer. Staff could check the website for information. An email could be sent to staff regarding the change before school ends. The district would still need to send letters to new staff. This letter would include the web address needed to register. The district is exploring possible ways to do this.
